Lincoln Christening Scene

101 N Chicago Street Lincoln, Illinois Lincoln christened the town with the juice of a watermelon on August 27, 1853. A watermelon statue and interpretive panel mark the site.

The Lincoln Heritage Museum exhibits a rare and valuable collection of artifacts that tell the story of the life and times of Abraham Lincoln.

Mt. Pulaski Courthouse

113 S. Washington Mt. Pulaski, Illinois 217.732.8930 This two-story brick Greek revival courthouse was constructed in 1848 and served as the Logan County seat of government until 1855. This courthouse is one of two original structures that remain in Illinois of the Eight Judicial Circuit, the twiceyearly circuit Abraham Lincoln traveled as a lawyer.

Postville Courthouse

914 5th Street Lincoln, Illinois 217.732.8930 The building is a reproduction of the first Logan County Courthouse in use from 1840 to 1847. Abraham Lincoln served as a lawyer on the Eighth Judicial Circuit.

J. H. Hawes Grain Elevator

301 SW Arch Street Atlanta, Illinois 309.830.8306 Illinois' only fully restored wooden grain elevator listed on the National Register of Historic Places. An outdoor, self-guided interpretive tour allows visitors to experience the Elevator Museum anytime.

HERITAGE AND CULTURAL EXPERIENCES

Bethel School

2646 Co Hwy 17 Emden, Illinois 217.376.3859 This one-room school house shows the environment that children learned in many years ago.

Elkhart Cemetery/Gillett Memorial Bridge/St.

John the Baptist Chapel Country Road 10 Elkhart, Illinois 217.947.2238 This 187 4 cemetery, the 1890 chapel, and this privately owned bridge are all pieces of memoirs of the Gillett family and their role in Elkhart's history.

Logan County Courthouse

601 Broadway Street Lincoln, Illinois 217.732.2184 Erected in-1905, the stone, three-story, domed structure is considered the second most architecturally spectacular courthouse in Illinois' 102 counties.



Mt Pulaski Courthouse

113 South Washington Mt. Pulaski, Illinois This two-story brick Greek revival courthouse was constructed in 1848 and served as the Logan County seat of government until 1855. This courthouse and Metamora Courthouse are the only original structures that remain in Illinois of the Eight Judicial Circuit, the twice-yearly circuit Abraham Lincoln traveled as a lawyer.

Walldog Murals

Logan County embraces their past with 11 beautifully painted murals in downtown Lincoln and 6 in downtown Atlanta. These murals are a must see.

Hunt for Heritage Waysides

Be on the lookout for Heritage Waysides in Atlanta, Elkhart, Emden, Lincoln, Middletown and Mt. Pulaski. These exhibits explain Abraham Lincoln's connection to Logan County and offer a great look into the history of our 16th president.

Bunyon Statue

103 SW Arch Street Atlanta, Illinois Originally located in front of Bunyon's restaurant on Route 66 in Cicero, Illinois, the 19-foot Bunyon Statue now welcomes Route 66 travelers to Atlanta.

Palms Grill Cafe

11 0 SW Arch Street Atlanta, Illinois 217.648.2233 Blue-plate specials, bingo, and a bus stop! Lovingly restored to its circa 1935 appearance, the cafe now invites visitors to step back in time and experience the way it used to taste.

Route 66 Arcade Museum

114 SW Arch Street Atlanta, Illinois The museum is chock full of vintage pinball and video games from the 1930s-1970s, most of which can be played. It's the perfect place to misspend your youth all over again, one quarter at a time!

Pig Hip Marker

101 W Oak Street Broadwell, Illinois An icon of Route 66, the Pig Hip Restaurant was open from 1937 to 1991, and served as a popular museum from 1991 to 2007.

The Mill on 66

738 Washington Lincoln, Illinois 217.671.3790 Now open Tues-Sat 1pm-4pm April-October or by appointment . Opened in 1929 under the name of the Blue Mill, it served grilled cheese sandwiches. The Mill closed in 1996. In 2007, work began to restore the building as a roadside attraction.

Railsplitter Covered Wagon

1750th 5th Street Lincoln, Illinois It is recognized in the Guinness Book of World Records as the world's largest covered wagon and was named #1 Roadside Attraction in America by Reader's Digest magazine.

Route 66 Log Chapel

Fifth & Logan Street Lincoln, Illinois 217.732.3946 Built by the Zion Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, this small log cabin next to Route 66 is open for travelers.


Shopping


